Similar to the reverb, the echo in TotalMixFX is well suited for a variety of spacious and rhythmic effects. With only a few parameters, the echo can enhance your vocals, add more life to instrument tracks or can act as a sound generator.

On the right hand side of TotalMixFX click on "Show Effects" to open the panel. Note that the echo, as well as the reverb, is a send effect on a separate stereo effects buss and not an insert effect, thus not available on the individual input and output channels.

Three types of echoes are available: Stereo Echo, Stereo Cross and Pong Echo. The parameters for each echo type are the same.

The delay time can be entered either in milliseconds or beats per minute for fine control over note values. Increasing the feedback amount creates further echoes which leads to more complex and distinct delays. Width" adjusts the stereo image of the echo from stereo to mono, while the level of the echo return bus can be adjusted with the "Volume" control.
